

# Field screening process

## Introduction and background

- Screening is done to screen for those with highest possibility of having TB among participants
- Screening tools
  - Interview using standard TB symptom questionnaire – all participants
  - Chest X-ray – all participants
  - Those positive either interview or xray or both- sputum is collected. (estimated 20-25%)



# Field screening process

## Introduction and background

- **Reception** or informed consent unit
- **Interview** for individual symptom screening unit
- **X-ray** unit- X-ray Taking
- **Medical Officer's** unit- X-ray reading
- **Team Leader's** unit- decision for sputum collection
- **Field laboratory** unit- sputum collection
- **Logistics** unit- Tshirt & juice distribution





# Major roles and responsibilities of DTLO

- Ensure that all staff are placed adequately and in flow is in order
- Facilitate the team in all units as necessary
- Facilitate to mitigate any administrative / technical issues during field operation and coordinate as required.
- Support TL to do mop up assessment and develop mop up plan
- Assure that mop up is being carried out as planned
- Assure that SOP is being followed and quality is being maintained

**DTLOs are the key GoN focal point for quality assuring the PS locally**
