

Follow up in Prevalence Survey after field operation

- Providing result of screening tests (sputum examination and X-ray) to the District (Public) Health Office and then to the cluster Health Facility to the participants through regular health system
- collecting sputum sample of suspects either due to needing recollection or result of x-ray reading is changed to abnormal and is labeled as eligible for sputum collection by central radiology team or **QA team**
- Ensuring enrollment of diagnosed active TB cases during prevalence survey, for treatment as per NTP guideline



Major roles and responsibilities

Regional TB/Leprosy Officer/RHD:

- Copied of all concerned information from NTC and districts

Major roles and responsibilities

District TB/Leprosy Officer (DHO):

- Provide the survey examination results to the health facility that are received from PSS/NTC and ensure that each participant receive the information of examination results through health system
- Ensure local HF mobilises local health staff to collect sputum sample of the suspects
- Ensure and manage timely transportation of these samples to central laboratory
- Ensure enrollment of diagnosed active TB cases during prevalence survey, for treatment as per NTP guideline



Major roles and responsibilities

HF incharge (Cluster level):

- Receive survey examination results from D(P)HO and provide information to each of the participant
- Mobilize local health staff to collect sputum sample of the suspects
- Manage timely transportation of the collected samples to central laboratory
- Enroll diagnosed active TB cases during prevalence survey, for treatment as per NTP guideline
